## What should you do if your teen:

Is absent from school	Ring the College office. When they return to school write a note to your teen's group teacher giving the reason for their absence.
Is being bullied	Contact the appropriate year level Dean immediately.
Is depressed or unhappy	Contact the Guidance Counsellor.
Is finding work too easy or difficult	Contact the appropriate year level Dean.
Is not getting enough homework	Contact the appropriate year level Dean.
Needs help with future choices	Contact the Careers Advisor.
Has lost something	Contact the school office.
Does not have the correct uniform	Provide your teen with a note indicating the reason for the non-regulation uniform and indicate when you are able to get this fixed.
Needs information about sports	Contact the Sports Coordinator.
Wants to learn an instrument	Make contact with Mr Hancy – Head of Music.
Is concerned about payments for school fees, sports, trips or exams	Contact the College office who can arrange automatic payments to cover these and spread payment across the year. In some situations where families are having financial difficulty, we can assist families and ensure students are not disadvantaged. In this case contact the Guidance Counsellor.
Is having health concerns	Make an appointment at the school office to see the Health Nurse who visits weekly.
